Values-based Child Development Education (VCDE) Credential*

The Values-based Child Development Education Credential has been developed to provide an option for those who are located in a secular setting, but who do not have a character development curriculum in place as part of their daily routine. The VCDE requires identification of 18 key values taught throughout the year. The lesson plans required for the portfolio must reflect teaching strategies used to teach moral values to young children. An Observation Tool, Interview and Portfolio Review will be used to assess character development curriculum implementation during the Verification Visit.
